


Introduction

The first time that you logged-in to Okta you completed the [Okta Enrollment Steps](#). Now, each time you log in from a non-Tyson computer or a mobile device, you will be prompted for an additional layer of authentication after you enter your password. This multi-step authentication process is called Multi-Factor Authentication, or MFA, and is designed to keep Tyson data safe.

1	<p>Open your preferred web browser and navigate to https://login.tyson.com. Make sure that you have your mobile device with you before you begin.</p> <p>Enter the email address and password associated with your account and click Sign In.</p>

1. Click **Send Push**

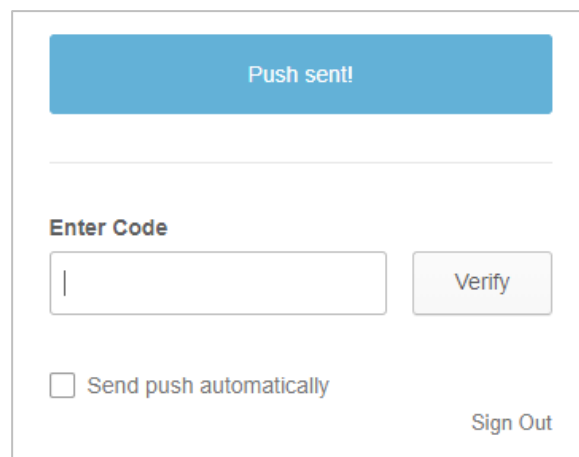
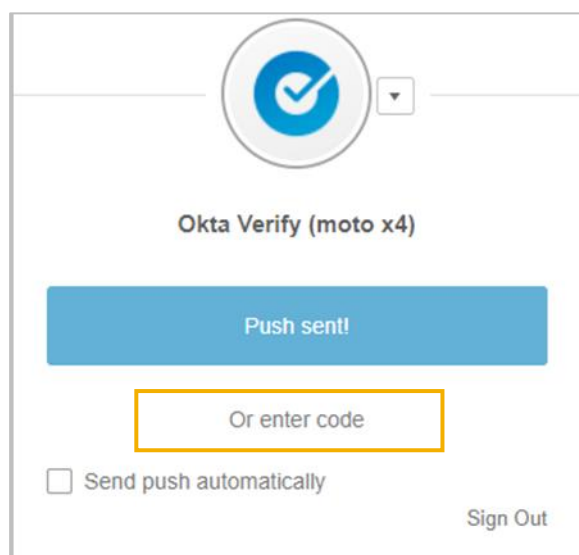
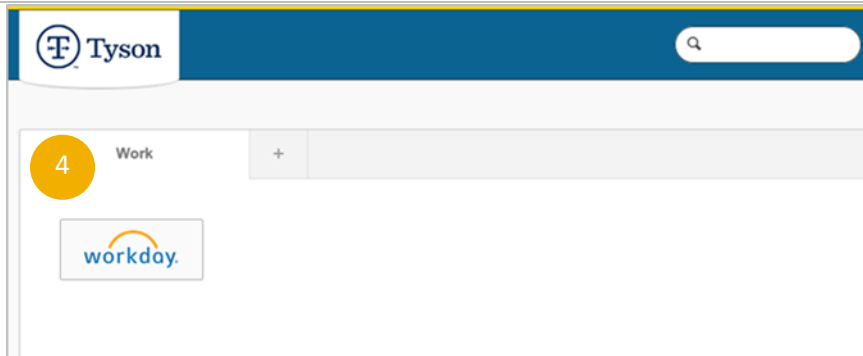

4. Once your push response has processed, your account will be logged-in on the home screen. **You are done.**

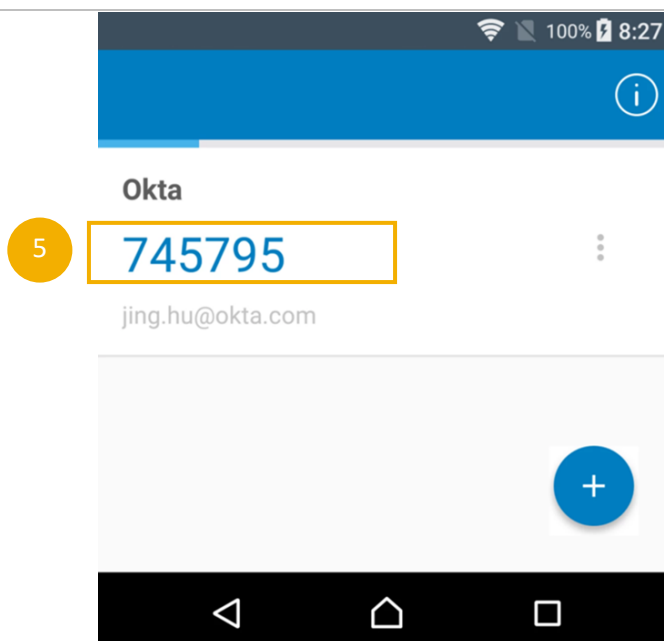
If you never see the question prompt in the Okta Verify app, even after waiting a few minutes, click **enter code**. *You do not have to do both the push and the code.*

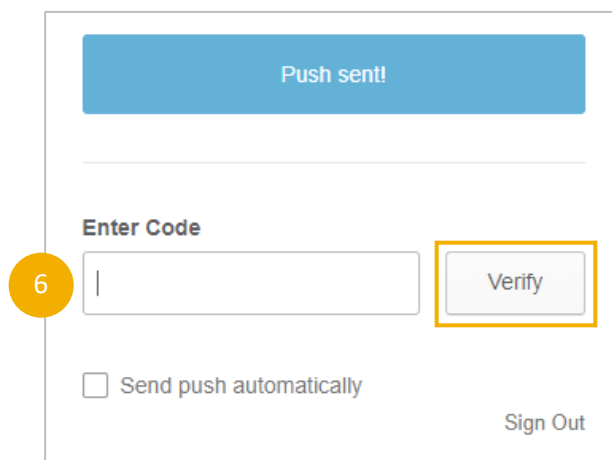

5. **From your mobile device:**
Look in the Okta mobile app for the 6-digit **numeric code listed above your username.**

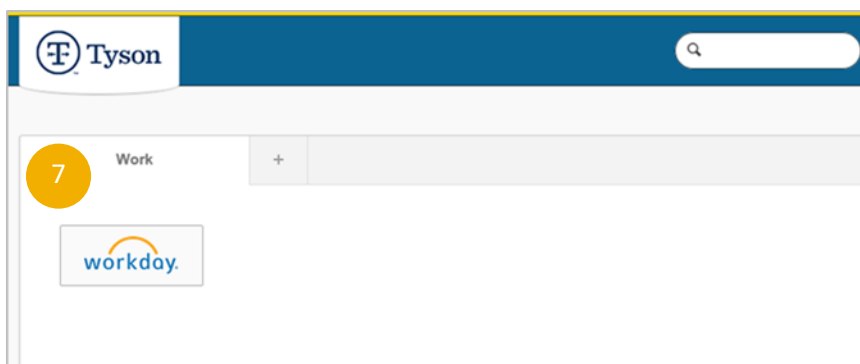


6. **From the Okta login page:** enter the 6-digit numeric code. **Click Verify.**

Important: This code changes every 30 seconds, so **do not delay in entering the code.**




7. Your account will be logged-in on the home screen. **You are done.**

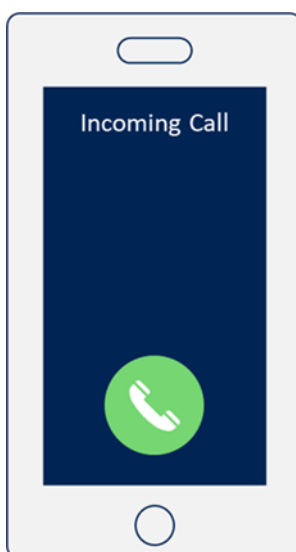
If you do not have Okta Verify configured, you will see the **Voice Call Authentication screen** after entering your username and password at the login screen in section 1. **Click Call.**

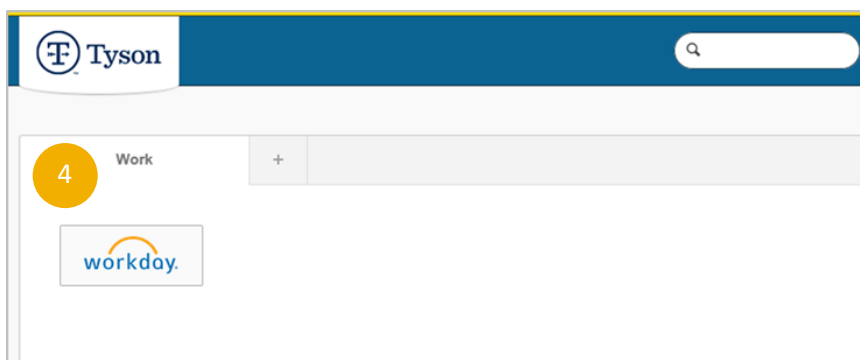
